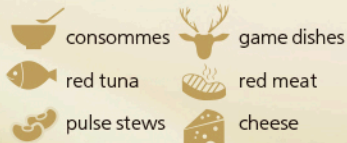

The Solera of Río Viejo was founded in 1918. Aged in American oak casks through the traditional "Solera y Criaderas" system for over 10 years. It takes its name from the country estate "Río Viejo", located on the banks of the Guadalete river, on the outskirts of Jerez.

TASTING NOTES:

Dark gold in colour with elegant smoky wood aromas. Full flavours of bitter chocolate and walnuts. This wine has an intense, long and concentrated aftertaste, with a tangy acidity.
